FEDERAL PELL GRANT

- Entitlement Funding Ugrds, Ist time degree seeking, res & non res
- Awarding Amounts and Eligibility determined the Federal Government
- Deadlines do not apply
- Lifetime eligibility = 600%

FEDERAL SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY GRANT (FSEOG)

- Limited funding awarded to WSU
- Deadlines apply
- Residents receiving Pell Grant, awarded a \$100 match
- Non Residents with an EFC below \$12,000 receive a maximum of \$1250
- Student can receive at 6 credits and above

WSU COUGAR COMMITMENT AWARD

- Deadlines apply
- Resident, Undergrad, Ist time degree seeking
- Funding source may be in the form of Grant or Waiver
- Student must be receiving Pell Grant and or SNG and meet admit terms of eligibility to be considered for this funding source.
- Award levels based on campus attending
- Remember that in many cases, the Pell and SNG cover the cost of tuition and fees which means the student is not eligible for Cougar Commitment.

WSU INSTITUTIONAL GRANT

- Resident, Undergrad Degree seeking students, deadlines apply
- Allocations determined by WSU Budget Office, limited funding
- EFC < or = 12,000
- Student is <u>not</u> receiving Pell Grant or State Need Grant

Exception cases: Student exhausts eligibility for Pell and/or SNG.

WASHINGTON STATE NEED GRANT

- Resident, Undergraduate Degree Seeking students
- Deadlines apply (exception if CB eligible), WSU awards up to 60% MFI
- Award Amounts and Eligibility parameters set by WSAC,
- Limited funding provided by WSAC
- Along with FAFSA/WASFA application information, eligibility based on MFI, chart provided by WSAC.
- Student has 10 semesters of eligibility

WASHINGTON COLLEGE BOUND Scholarship

- Resident, Undergraduate Degree Seeking
- Award Amounts & Eligibility parameters set by WSAC
- Entitlement funding provided by WSAC, no set amount allocated
- WSAC sets the minimum MFI range of 65% to be used in WSU's awarding policy
- Along with WASFA/FAFSA information, eligibility based on MFI range
- Student must receive their State Need Grant Award first and the remaining funds up to CB award are awarded in College Bound
- New change: Students receiving Washington Opportunity Award, if more than CB award, will not be eligible for funds
- Student has a total of 8 semesters of eligibility

MANUAL AWARD POSTING REMINDERS

- After aid has disbursed, the system will automatically want to reduce the undisbursed (spring) part of a loan, so you'll need to manually adjust the loan if the scholarship was also an even split.
- If the award being posted is creating an overneed situation, you may need to swap a portion of the Subsidized Loan into Unsubsidized Loan which then will correctly reduce the Plus Loan.
- If increasing a loan, need to add a new record if first loan has already certified.
- Important areas to pay attention to on the Assign Awards Page
 - Student Aid Package
 - Need Summary Tab
 - Term Summary Tab

MANUAL AWARD POSTING REMINDERS CONTINUED.....

- Disbursement plans:
 - 01/01 = fall/spring
 - 02/01 = fall semester
 - 03/01 = spring semester
 - 06/01 = fall/spring/summer semester
- 06/01 disbursement plan
 - Provides the most flexibility for adjustments, especially if funds could be awarded in the summer
 - Need to do a custom split when using 06/01 to ensure funds are correctly assigned to each term

DISBURSEMENT TROUBLESHOOTING

- Navigating hold reasons in myWSU
 - Assign Awards Page
 - View Financial Aid Status Page
 - Disburse Aid Page, referring to term and messaging
- Most scholarships require minimum of 12 credits for aid to disburse
- While full time tuition is charged at 10-18 credits, most financial aid does not disburse unless a student is enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits.
- Student asking about funds we've accounted for as a placeholder, refer to student account to see if funds have applied, if not student needs to check with source aid was awarded from.

OTHER MISCELLANEOUS REMINDERS

- Graduate & VetMed students are packaged with Resident cost-of-attendance.
- If a Graduate student is notifying our office that they are or are not receiving a graduate assistant waiver, SFS will remove the waiver and repackage the student.
- A student does not have to be enrolled to receive a financial aid package.
- The weekly revalidation process will continue to run up until the Monday prior to the Financial Aid Census process the following Saturday.
- Post Revalidation processing, weekly QC reports are being run be various SFS team members.

DISBURSEMENT TIMELINE AND CENSUS DAY REMINDERS

- August 13th, first fall disbursement date
- Student has to be enrolled, with charges on their account for the rest of the aid disbursement process to occur as long as no other disbursement holds (verification, SAP, etc....)
- Fall Financial Aid Census Day Saturday, September 1st
 - Financial Aid Census Aid that will hold if student is not enrolled in fulltime and then will be adjusted based on enrollment at Financial Aid Census Day enrollment snapshot
 - Pell Grant, SNG, College Bound, Institutional Grant, WSU Grant
 - Special run of disbursement scheduled to occur Monday afternoon, September 3rd to disburse adjusted Census Day aid.
